Online Payment Instructions

Leisure Town Home Association (116)

Step by step set up for online automatic payment

- 1. One-time E-Check Payment (at no cost to you).
- 2. One-time Credit Card Payment (fee applies at time of transaction*).
- 3. Recurring E-Check Payment (at no cost to you).

*3% of the amount charged if a Visa Credit Card is used or a flat fee of \$5 if he pays by Visa Debit Card every time a payment is made.

- Go to <u>www.omnicommunities.com</u>
- 2.) Scroll to the middle of the screen and select "PAY ONLINE"
- Select Alliance Bank Pay Online Click 'Setup account' (bottom of the page) to pay with your bank account or you can pay onetime e-check payment or credit card payment
- 4.) Fill out the Setup Account information Once complete, you will then be sent a verification email. The email will contain a link to the login page that allows you to continue the setup of your automatic payment using the password you just created.
- Upon completing your account setup and you have logged in, please select Setup Scheduled Payments.
- 6.) Click 'Add a property' to add the subject property. Once that is complete, select "Add a Payment Method" to add your desired bank account.
- There will be three pieces of information needed to find your unit (see below) or enter your address.

Enter the amount of your assessment payment, select the frequency you want this payment debited from your account (monthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually) and select the date you would like the payment to begin. Once completed, select Review Payment at the bottom of the screen to submit your schedule payment.


- Jul 29, 2024: Pro Elections mails Nominations Reminder Notice to all Association members.

- ELECTION PROCESS ENDS HERE IF THE NUMBER OF CANDIDATES IS LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO THE NUMBER OF SEATS UP FOR ELECTION (ELECTION BY ACCLAMATION). IF NOT, THE PROCESS CONTINUES AS FOLLOWS:
- Sep 13, 2024: Pro Elections mails Pre-Ballot Notice to all Association members.
- Sep 27, 2024: Deadline for reporting corrections to voter & candidate list to Pro Elections.
- Oct 17, 2024: Pro Elections mails Ballot Package to all Association members.
- Nov 18, 2024: Deadline for voting.
- Nov 19, 2024: Ballots are counted and election is certified by the Inspector of Elections.

LTHA is Private Property

Leisure Town, including the pool area, is private property and is not open to non-residents (unless present with a member and following all published and posted rules regarding signing in, including the date/time, number of guests and their ages).

Due to an increase in non-compliance in the pool area the LTHA Board of Directors has instructed staff to:

1. Call the police to remove non-residents if necessary.

2. Call the police to remove persons (including members) who become verbally abusive or threatening to staff or others.

3. Deactivate the access card of any member who is verbally abusive or threatening, violates the pool rules, and/or who provides gate access to non-members or unknown persons.

No pool access is allowed without a key card. Do not hold the gate open for others. ALL must sign-in.

Architectural Approval

Per section 8, of the CC&Rs, it is important to keep in mind, *no exterior addition or change or alteration may be made, until the plans and specifications showing the nature, kind, shape, color, height, size, materials, and location of the same have been submitted to the Architectural Committee and approved in writing by the Board.*

We kindly remind you to submit an ARC application to obtain preapproval <u>prior to</u> <u>beginning any exterior projects.</u>

Pools/Spa OPEN

The pools and spa are open.

Violations are continuing to be observed and the Board of Directors may consider severely limiting the pools hours, and/or hiring security if problems continue.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SWIMMING POOLS AND SPA AREAS

(as defined by everything within the fence except the Fitness Center)

FOR YOUR SAFETY - DO NOT SWIM OR USE THE SPA ALONE

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

1	The swimming pools and spa area are maintained for the use of Leisure
	Town residents and their guests.
2	Each household is permitted four (4) guests.
3	Residents must always accompany their guests.
4	Pools are open daily from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. April to October and 8 a.m. to 7
	p.m. October through April. No one is allowed in the pool or spa areas after
	closing time. The hours are subject to change by Management.
5	Guests aged 5-17 years are allowed to use the swimming pools ONLY
	between 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. They are not permitted in the area before 11 a.m.
	or after 2 p.m., except on Sundays when the hours will be extended from 11
	a.m. to 5 p.m.
6	Children under 5 years of age are not permitted in the pools at any time.
7	Priority of this facility is reserved for scheduled activities by the residents,
	i.e. swimming classes and water aerobics.
8	You MUST shower off at the outside shower facility before using either pool
	or spa in order to keep our pools and spa clean.
9	Baby or adult diapers not allowed in order to keep our pools and spa clean.
10	No one with infectious diseases, rashes, open sores, or bandages is allowed
	use of the pools or spa.
11	Alcohol or food is not permitted in the pool area. Water and non-alcoholic
	beverages are acceptable in an unbreakable container.
12	Smoking of any kind including vaping is strictly prohibited.
13	For safety reasons, toys are not allowed. Small floats (floatation chairs and
	noodles are allowed for safety reasons). Large (air mattress/lounge sized
	floats) are prohibited. Be respectful of other users within the pool.
14	Running, jumping, diving and general horseplay are strictly prohibited.
15	Appropriate swimming apparel is required at all times.
16	No pets are allowed in the pool area.
17	Clean up after yourself.
18	Violators may have their privileges revoked and/or be subject to a fine, as
	defined by the LTHA Fine Policy.




