

Step by step set up for online automatic payment

- 1. One-time E-Check Payment (at no cost to you).
- 2. One-time Credit Card Payment (fee applies at time of transaction*).
- 3. Recurring E-Check Payment (at no cost to you).

*3% of the amount charged if a Visa Credit Card is used or a flat fee of \$5 if he pays by Visa Debit Card every time a payment is made.

- 1.) Go to www.omnicommunities.com
- 2.) Scroll to the middle of the screen and select "PAY ONLINE"
- Select Alliance Bank Pay Online Click 'Setup account' (bottom of the page) to pay with your bank account or you can pay onetime e-check payment or credit card payment
- 4.) Fill out the Setup Account information Once complete, you will then be sent a verification email. The email will contain a link to the login page that allows you to continue the setup of your automatic payment using the password you just created.
- Upon completing your account setup and you have logged in, please select Setup Scheduled Payments.
- 6.) Click 'Add a property' to add the subject property. Once that is complete, select "Add a Payment Method" to add your desired bank account.
- There will be three pieces of information needed to find your unit (see below) or enter your address.

8.) Enter the amount of your assessment payment, select the frequency you want this payment debited from your account (monthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually) and select the date you would like the payment to begin. Once completed, select Review Payment at the bottom of the screen to submit your schedule payment.
